

HB53 Training Policy DRAFT

To be approved by the Utah Office for Victims of Crime the training must be:

a minimum of 40 hours that includes:

- trauma-informed training in crisis response
- effects of crime and trauma on victims
- victim advocacy services and ethics
- informed consent, and this part regarding privileged confidential communication
